

# Ketchikan Halibut Derby RULES

## **1. Date and Fees**

Single ticket price is \$25.00. Family ticket price is \$40.00 and includes spouse, children and grandchildren under the age of 18.

Derby week-ends: July 10 & 11, 17 & 18, and 24 & 25, 2010 – 7 am to 7 pm.

Prize drawing for all ticket holders will be held July 31, 2009 at the SSEABIA Annual Family Picnic at Ward Lake.

## **2. Fishing Areas**

No boundaries have been set, but you must be back by 7 pm for check-in to qualify for the derby.

## **3. Condition of Participation**

All persons onboard a boat over the age of 6 years must have a derby ticket unless the boat is chartered, in which case the captain is excluded.

You may only enter fish caught after the purchase of a derby ticket.

CONTESTANTS MUST HOOK AND PLAY EVERY FISH UNAIDED, other than by gaffing or netting.

Anglers must comply with the Alaska Fish and Game regulations.

Contestants are prohibited from fishing from a boat with commercial gear in use or engaged in commercial fishing. A derby contestant may not enter a derby fish on the same day that he or she has been commercial fishing.

Contestants are required to display sportsman-like conduct at all times. A contestant who interferes with another angler in any manner will be subject to disqualification.

All members of the Ketchikan Halibut Derby committee and the Board of Directors are eligible to participate in the derby.

The Southern Southeast Alaska Building Industry Association, its Board of Directors, and others participating in the sponsorship of this derby accept no responsibility for damages or injuries sustained by contestants. As a condition of and in consideration of the acceptance of their entries therein, all contestants and their parents or guardian shall be deemed to agree and assume all risks of injury to the competitor's property and person, resulting from, caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the competition, and to release any and all claims which they may have against officials, the Ketchikan Halibut derby committee and it's Board of Directors and organizations that

take part in the sponsorship of this Derby. Participation accepted only on these conditions.

THE DECISIONS OF THE KETCHIKAN HALIBUT DERBY COMMITTEE ARE FINAL IN ANY CONTESTED MATTER. – Contests must be in writing to the Derby Committee within 3 days of the last fishing day of the derby.

**4. Weigh In** - All fish must be weighed in by the registered angler at the weigh stations by 7:00 pm. Weigh in will be from 1:00 pm to 7 pm. Official weigh in stations are located at Mountain Point, Clover Pass Resort, and Cedar's Lodge.

**5. Alaska State Rules** - All anglers must have a 2010 Alaska Department of Fish and Game fishing license. All anglers must comply with all Alaska Dept. of Fish and Game regulations. Accusations of ADF&G rule violations must be reported directly to the Alaska State Troopers at 225-5118. Safety equipment must be in compliance with Coast Guard regulations.

#### **6. Prizes**

Hidden weights will be between 20 – 150 pounds and are blindly drawn by Committee members and sealed in an envelope to be opened after the derby closes on July 25<sup>th</sup>. The winning fish will be the fish that is closest to the hidden weight (over or under). In the event of a tie, the weight closest to the hidden weight that is not over the hidden weight will win – in the event of a dead on tie, the fish weighed in first will win. If the tying fish are turned in at the same time, the prize will be split between the tying anglers.

Fish must be weighed in the round (including head, viscera, gills, and tail) and must be weighed in on the same day that it was caught. The Committee encourages the release of juvenile halibut and as such, any Halibut weighed in below 10 lbs will not qualify for a prize (daily or overall) and will not be recorded on the derby ladder.

Need not be present to win. All entries and awarding of prizes are subject to review and final determination by the Ketchikan Halibut Derby Committee.

The Southern Southeast Alaska Building Industry Association reserves the right to: photograph all derby entrants, reproduce any photographs for publicity purposes, and retain all photo rights.

All prize winners are responsible for all taxes and fees associated with prize winnings. Prizes may be subject to withholding based on IRS requirements.
